Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship Process to Begin Soon

This year, the Texas 4-H Foundation will be presenting over \$2.1 million in scholarships. To prepare Districts 1 and 2 4-H members, their parents and County Extension Agents to complete the Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship application, eight Scholarship Workshops will be held in December and January. Centra trainings will be held on November 12th and 16th, December 2nd, 7th and 17th and January 6th. In-person trainings will be conducted on December 3rd at the Research and Extension Center in Amarillo and December 10th at the Research and Extension Center in Lubbock. **All trainings will begin at 6:30.** The workshop is geared towards high school seniors, but will also provide needed information to anyone in grades 8-11. **It is never too early to start the scholarship process!**

Items to be covered are: what you need to complete the application; scholarship process; application formats; types of scholarships and their requirements; parts of the application and requirements for each; and tips for preparing your application. This will also be an excellent time to ask questions.

In 2009, with the two districts combined, our 4-H members were awarded almost \$400,000! Let's keep that momentum going.
