








2023 Spring Validation Tag Orders

If you plan to enter/exhibit an animal at the State Fair of Texas and Heart Of Texas, please submit your validation tag order through the link provided below.

There are a few new changes, so please be sure to read your livestock project information below.

IMPORTANT TO KNOW FOR EACH LIVESTOCK PROJECT:

Market Steers

- This is the only validation tag order/physical validation period. Once validated in June, steers are eligible for Fall Fairs and Spring Majors for 1 year.

Breeding Heifers

- Ear Tags All state validated heifers will be ear tagged similar to steers.
 - Heifers that are already validated and have not changed breed or ownership, do not need to be revalidated with a tag. Only newly validated heifers will get a tag and will be charged the new validation fee. As always, if a heifer changes ownership or breed, they must be revalidated.
- Will be charged per ear tag just like steers.
- There are two validation tag order/physical validation periods.
 - Spring Once validated in June, heifers are eligible for Fall Fairs and Spring Majors for 2 years.
 - Fall Once validated in October, heifers are eligible for Spring Majors and the next year's Fall Fairs for 2 years.
- Heifers validated this spring or last fall remain eligible (and does not need to be revalidated) for the remainder of her show career unless a change is made to breed or ownership.

State Fair Lamb & Goat

- Lambs and goats validated during the 2023 State Fair Validation Period WILL BE ELIGIBLE for 2024 Spring Major Shows. Market animals validated for the 2023 State Fair will carryover for 2024 Spring Major Shows. Once validated, the project MUST stay in the care of the exhibitor that project is validated to; if the exhibitor chooses to sell the project to a new exhibitor, the new exhibitor MUST REVALIDATE the project within the next validation period.

State Fair Swine

- REGISTERED GILTS Registration papers are due to the office by July 6th.
- Projects that have been state fair validated must be re-validated for Spring Majors.

Do I need to order tags?

If you are going to show any of the following livestock projects: {Steer | Heifer | Lamb | Goat | Swine} at any of the following Fall Fairs: {State Fair of Texas | Heart Of Texas}, you will need to order a validation tag for each livestock project.
